

## HAS SOMEONE'S DRINKING AFFECTED YOUR LIFE?

### Al-Anon is:

- A fellowship of relatives and friends of alcoholics who believe their lives have been affected by someone else's drinking.
- A mutual support recovery program based on the 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous.
- A non-professional fellowship where members share their experience, strength, and hope to solve their common problems.
- A program with the single purpose of helping families and friends of alcoholics whether the alcoholic is still drinking or not.

### Al-Anon is not:

- \* Allied with any sect, denomination, political entity, organization, or institution.
- \* Involved in any outside issues-neither endorses nor opposes any cause.
- \* Affiliated with AA, although both fellowships cooperate with one another.
- \* Considered a religious organization, treatment center, provider, counseling agency, or teaching program.
- \* Conducted by professionals.
- \* Intended as a replacement for professional treatment or counseling.

### Alateen is:

- \* A fellowship of young Al-Anon members, usually teenagers, whose lives have been affected by someone else's drinking.

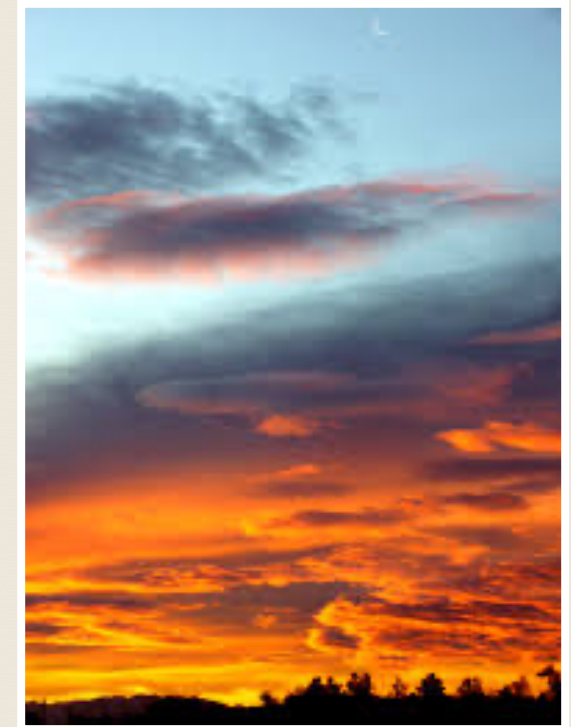

1. Download Zoom app

4. Type in meeting ID/password
